


### Approximately when, if ever, did you start to know you wanted to attend graduate school?








### Approximately when, if ever, did you start to apply to graduate school?






# While considering graduate school, how much encouragement did you get (or are you getting) for attending from...?








# When you were considering graduate school, how much information did you receive about graduate school?




#### Looking back, how accurate was the information about graduate school?









# When you were considering graduate school, how much information did you receive about potential careers?









## When you were considering graduate school, how much information did you receive about potential careers?








# When you were considering graduate school, how helpful was the information you received about potential careers?




## When you were considering graduate school, how much information did you receive about potential careers?







### Looking back, how accurate was the information about potential careers?








## A graduate degree provides me with better career opportunities.



















#### A Graduate Degree Will Increase My Income Potential








# How likely is it you would encourage others in your career to attend graduate school?





### Given what you know now, would you still attend graduate school?






## Given what you know now, would you still attend graduate school?













### Why wouldn't you attend graduate school, given what you know now?






#### What were your reasons for pursuing a graduate degree?




